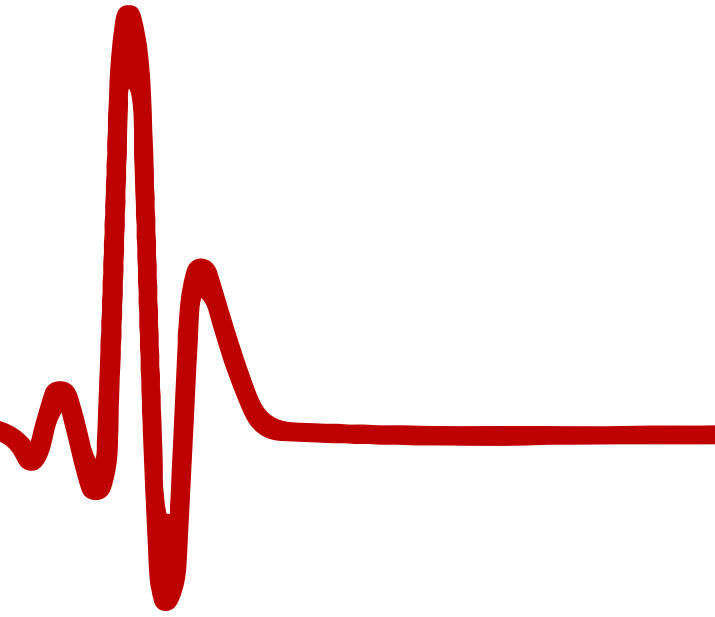


COMMUNITY TALK ON OVERDOSE RESPONSE
