GETTING STARTED

Children who will turn five years old before January 1, 2020 are eligible to begin school in September 2019.

Registration begins Monday, January 14, 2019
To register, please contact your local school (for school catchment areas, please view www.surreyschools.ca or call 604-595-5195)

Please bring the following documents upon registration at the school:
In-person registration is required at the neighbourhood school. The following documents are required at the school when registering:

- 1. Proof of birth date for the student** (birth certificate or passport).
- 2. Proof of guardianship** (as shown on child's birth certificate or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardianship order).
- 3. Proof of Citizenship** for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card).
- 4. Proof of residence** (e.g., ordinarily resident) of parent/guardian in BC:
 - Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
 - One of the three pieces above must be government issued in order to complete the registration process (BC driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian).

Documents which are helpful, but not required:

- **Health Documents** (Care Card, immunization records, medical condition information)

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Online kindergarten registration applies to the four Choice programs below only.

HOW DO I APPLY

The application will be online Monday, January 28, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. Parents will have three weeks to apply, edit and/or change their application until February 18, 2019.

Parents must register their child at their local catchment school prior to applying for a Kindergarten Program of Choice.

January 14 – Regular kindergarten registration opens at your local school

January 28 – Online application opens

February 13 – Deadline to register at catchment school in order to apply online for Programs of Choice

February 18 – Online application closes

February 25 to March 15 – Random draw takes place

During the weeks of **February 25 - March 15** An email will be sent to all applicants announcing the lottery results. The email will indicate whether your child has received a space in one of your selected choices and outline the next steps to accept or decline. Applicants not offered a space are automatically placed on a waitlist.
