## **CRITERIA**

The individual must be in grade 12 in a British Columbia school or in first year at a recognized post-secondary institution (for example, university, colleges offering transfer courses, institutions that prepare students for specific trades or vocations, and which are recognized and supported by the government, for example, BCIT). A valid student card or a receipt for tuition fees is required as proof of registration. The candidate's academic achievement will be based on a review of an official transcript of the candidate's academic record for grades 11 and 12. The candidate must be registered for a full course load at the post-secondary institution. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent resident status.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Application for this scholarship is in essay format. To apply applicants must write a minimum 500 word essay sharing what culture means to them, how they are promoting it and what they are going to do to continue creating a legacy for culture.
