



2019 Honey Hooser Scholarship

The City of Surrey has established the \$500 Honey Hooser Scholarship to be awarded each year to a Surrey resident who is one of the following: 1) a post-secondary arts student, 2) a senior secondary student or 3) an individual with disabilities who has demonstrated an interest in arts and crafts.

The purpose of this scholarship is to benefit the community by encouraging persons having an interest in arts and crafts to pursue studies in these areas. This interest may be interpreted in a broad fashion, including the study of the visual, graphic or performing arts, or the development of the tools to facilitate these arts.

Eligible candidates are required to include a cover letter (no more than 250 words) detailing their involvement in local arts and crafts as part of their application.
