### Online - for Surrey School District students only

- April 1** Full Credit registration for grade 11 & 12 opens
- April 8** Full Credit registration opens for all grades
- May 1** Remedial registration opens
- June 26** registration closes

Skills Exploration 10 will give students entering grade 10 the opportunity to experience a hands-on introduction to the construction trades of carpentry, electrical, plumbing and welding. Students will learn essential skills such as how to measure, cut, wire, build and weld; skills and attitudes needed for success in school and the workplace; benefits of Apprenticeship and Surrey District Partnership Programs, and career-related opportunities.

As this is a full day program and very labour intensive, students must be able to work independently on a job-site environment with minimum one-on-one instruction.
