### CANADIAN TIRE JUMPSTART

**\$58,500** has been donated to the Jumpstart Academy after-school programs. The funding will support activities that increase accessibility of physical wellness and fundamental movement based programs. Jumpstart Academy allows a diverse population of participants in grades K-7 to increase their fundamental movement skills in a fun, safe and inclusive environment. Over 2,500 students across the district will participate in Jumpstart Academy programming from Jan-June 2020.

### CHARITY FOUNDATION OF CANADA

From March-December, the Charity Foundation of Canada has donated to **18 schools** across the district to help support expanded learning opportunities for students. These donations allow schools to provide additional field trips, new technology, and school supplies for students to have enriched hands-on learning experiences and expose them to new exciting opportunities. 7,000 students will directly benefit from the support provided by Charity Foundation of Canada.



### STAND FOUNDATION

**\$10,000** donation from the STAND Foundation enables the continuation of the STAND Foundation employment training program at five of our Learning Centres. This program provides over 100 students with the opportunity to gain important pre-employment certifications and skills, which will assist them as they transition from secondary school to post-secondary and employment.

## SURREY FIRE FIGHTERS CHARITABLE SOCIETY

Over **120 schools** are benefiting from generous support provided through the Surrey Fire Fighters Charitable Society's *Nutritional Snack Program*. This program provides snacks for students that may otherwise be hungry at school. The program impacts over 2,000 students across the district. This program began in 1997 with only a handful of schools, and has since grown to support almost every school in our district. ## UNITED WAY

**\$180,000** has been provided to three Surrey Schools partner organizations for the collaborative delivery of afterschool programming. Through *United Way School's Out* funding, partners including HR MacMillan Space Centre, Canada SCORES, and Alexandra Neighborhood House are working with Surrey Schools to ensure students are receiving safe, supportive, and enriching learning opportunities outside of school time.

In addition, **\$10,000** has been provided to Clayton Heights Secondary for their *Clayton Secondary School Youth Future Leaders* program. This program provides youth with opportunities to gain leadership skills, participate in practical work experience, build skill development, and set them up for future success in securing long term career employment.
