Grade 4s and 7s will be completing the Foundational Skills Assessment (FSA) in Literacy and Numeracy, beginning the week of January 30. Parents will have already received a notice explaining the FSA and its purpose. Please contact me if you have any further questions.

There are many changes that have happened with curriculum in BC and we would like to share that information with parents. There are two upcoming events for parents to not only learn but experience the new curriculum. There will be an information session for parents only on Thursday, March 2nd. This will be followed by a second interactive session for parents and children on Thursday, April 13th. A RSVP will be sent home shortly for the first session in March. We look forward to seeing you at these two events.

The school office is noticing an increase in lates again along with a large number of absences for extended vacations. The increases in lates and absences due to vacation can not only put stress on the teacher and their overall curricular planning, but also creates stress for the students in their learning environment. As outlined in the school calendar, a reminder that regular attendance and punctuality are two key factors in your child's school success. Not only is this important to your child's learning, it is an important life skill. In addition, when children are absent from school, the continuity of their learning is disrupted resulting in gaps in learning. It is difficult for teachers to send home work as children lack the understanding gained through teacher direction. The school district calendar is planned so that there are meaningful periods of learning followed by meaningful breaks. Please try to schedule holidays during the breaks and to support your child being on time so that disruptions to student learning in the classroom can be minimized.

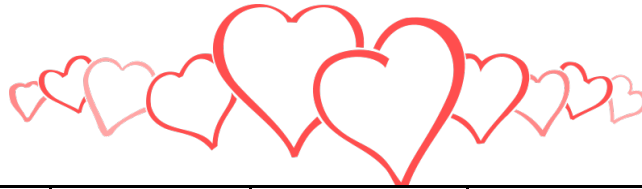
