Parents and students are advised of the following optional fees and workbook pricing for the 2016/17 school year. The school will provide the basic materials and resources necessary for students to meet the learning outcomes for each course.

Students will need to continue to provide their own basic supplies and equipment for their own personal use, such as paper, writing tools, calculators, notebooks, gym attire and musical instruments. Workbooks may be provided to students on loan or they may be purchased outright. Some courses, such as textiles and woodwork, provide students with the option of using different or better quality materials which they may bring from home or purchase from the school at cost. Some courses offer optional certifications or external examinations for which there are charges. Please note that the goal of field trips is to extend and enrich student learning. These trips are usually optional and charges to cover field trip expenses will apply.

LOCKERS – CONDITIONS OF USE

RULES REGARDING STUDENT LOCKERS: CONDITIONS OF USE

Each locker has a registered school lock that must be used – outside locks are not allowed. It is highly recommended that valuables (wallets, money, cell phones, i-pods) not be left in lockers, gym lockers or left unattended during class time.

Lockers are assigned to students for use during the school year on the following conditions:

1. Students are responsible for the locker which is assigned to them and it is not to be used by any other person.
2. Only registered school locks may be used on student lockers.
3. The locker may only be used for the storage of books, school supplies and equipment, outerwear, school sports equipment and lunches.
4. No other material is permitted except with the written authority of the principal or vice principal.
5. The locker is to be kept clean and food removed on a regular basis.
6. Students are responsible for cleaning and removing all material from their locker at the end of the year or when they leave the school.
7. No illegal substances, weapons or other prohibited or offensive material may be placed in school lockers.
8. School officials and/or designates may search student lockers at any time and without prior notice in order to ensure compliance with the conditions of use and other school policies and rules. Searches by school officials may include the use of dog units to detect the presence of narcotics or other prohibited materials.
9. Permission to use the locker may be terminated when a student does not comply with the conditions of use or school policies or rules.
10. It is the responsibility of all members of the school community to keep our schools safe. If any student has reason to believe that any locker contains anything which would threaten the safety of other students, staff or any other person, that student is expected to immediately report the information to a teacher or administrator. The name of the student making such a report will be kept confidential.

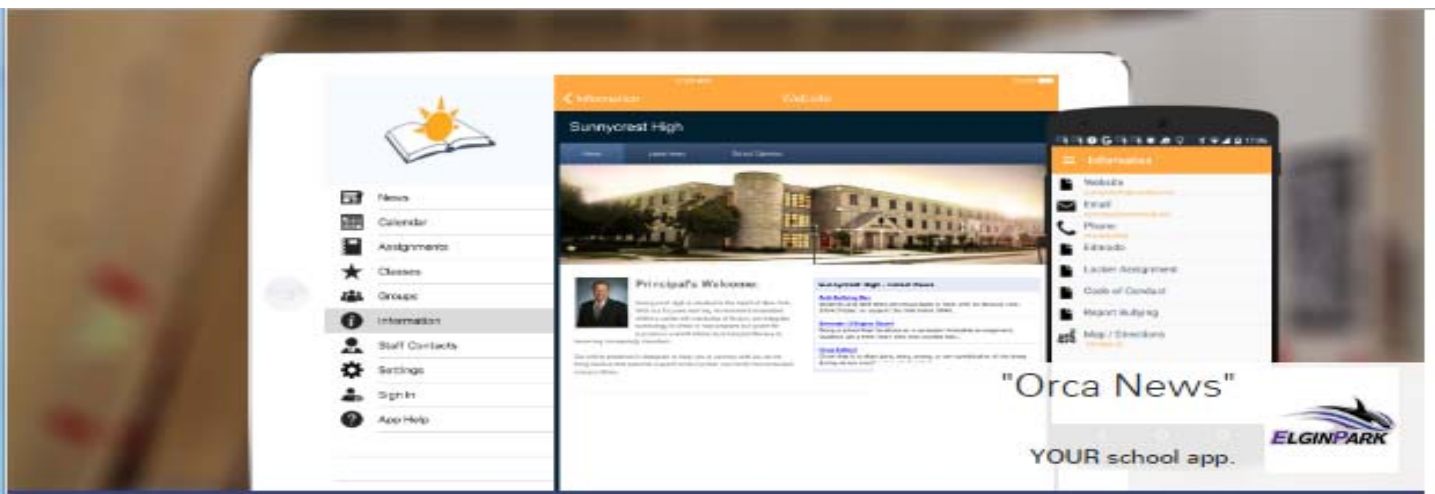

RE: Changes to GoCard discount for students starting September 1, 2016.

Dear Parent

As you may be aware, TransLink offers discounted transit fares to high school students across Metro Vancouver. Each year, over 120,000 secondary students are eligible to use concession fare products on TransLink's network, so long as they are travelling with valid student identification with a GoCard decal from their school as proof of eligibility.

Beginning this fall, we want to make it easier for eligible youth to use transit throughout the region and conveniently access concession fares.

Effective September 1, 2016, a GoCard decal will no longer be required on student IDs and all youth 14 to 18 years old will be eligible for concession fares with valid photo identification. Acceptable ID will include:

- a valid school identification card issued by any secondary school which displays the student's photograph, name, school and validation by a school official; or
- a picture identification issued by any national, provincial or state government agency showing age or date of birth.
