PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Parents and Students of the Fraser Heights Secondary School Community:

I hope this message finds you well. I hope you were able to enjoy the summer and find a little more time for family and relaxation. **We are clearly still in a pandemic and this is shaping everything we do.** Thank-you to everyone who has been very careful in expanding their 'social bubbles' and re-engaging in elements of 'normal' life, or something approaching how we lived prior to COVID 19. These actions make a big difference and need to continue. In July, Dr. Bonnie Henry, in conjunction with the Ministry of Education and the Provincial Government, determined that the social and educational 'cost' of continuing to keep students out of face-to-face direct instruction at school was just too high. Therefore, under the guidance and monitoring of the Provincial Health Officer, we will re-engage in September with a blended model of full time face-to-face instruction for Grade 8 and 9 students, and a mix of face-to-face and online learning for graduation (grade 10-12) program students. We are including a block order and bell schedule further within the newsletter. Our timetable strives to preserve as much of Fraser Height's student course choices as we can for our graduation program students while meeting the cohort grouping requirement of Dr. Henry. We continue to filter everything we consider through a lens of infection control and prevention. We also know that our health authorities will be closely monitoring COVID 19 levels and how those impact our health care system. We are prepared to change our instructional delivery, should adjustments be required.

Following the July 29th provincial announcement, we have been working to reconfigure our Grade 8 and 9 students into learning groups (students that travel together in the timetable). **This required us to re-timetable our Grade 8s and 9s and make a number of adjustments in how we deliver instruction,** (i.e.) we can no longer offer multi-grade classes, like Foods 9/10, at the junior level. Students are now being scheduled into two block 'learning groups' (also referred to as pods or cohorts). Each learning group travels, each quarter, from class to class with more or less the same students. These learning groups are 'reshuffled' each quarter. This way of timetabling keeps contact numbers down allowing classroom physical distancing requirements to be lower. It also facilitates contact tracing, should such a mechanism ever be required. Recently, the provincial government mandated that all students on buses and in common areas wear masks. **I expect many of our students and adults will wear masks all day, regardless of where they are.**

We will open with a **quarter system timetable** where students get two long blocks each day. The Surrey School District's current model is that **Grade 8 and 9 students receive two long block periods of direct face to face instruction each day.** They remain at school all day. Senior graduation program students, **Grades 10 through 12, receive a morning class featuring direct instruction, then their afternoon class is delivered through online**

learning. In addition, one third of each grade 10, 11 and 12 class stays for an afternoon face to face class on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. Their C block teacher puts them in one of these three groups. There they get direct instruction/assessment from their teacher. The one-third attendance allows these students face to face instruction/assessment, helps keep these students social distanced and maintains the senior learning group size at roughly thirty. We will use a district bell schedule and we are currently tinkering with the last bits of fine-tuning. This bell schedule features staggered start and end times for junior (grades 8-9) and senior (grades 10-12) students. On August 21st, our Superintendent submitted our organizational plan to the Ministry of Education. They respond on or before August 26th. We will continue our planning based on their feedback. Much of the thought behind our current timetable model is how do we provide as much face-to-face instruction as possible while keeping students and staff as safe as possible. One requirement to do this is to keep junior students with their learning cohort and to build a schedule where not everyone remains at school for the day. **When class ends, say at the start of lunch for most Grade 10 through 12 students, they have to leave the building. There is no opportunity for students to wait for their younger siblings within our building, etc.** We recognize this may be difficult, but we must keep our contact numbers low. We appreciate your support and cooperation with this reality.

Please take the opportunity to read through the newsletter. It is shortened as we just don't know how we are going to do many of the things we normally do. We have to be very cognizant of student interaction outside their cohort group. We now have a plan for the first two 'orientation' school days on September 10th and 11th. This is outlined further within the newsletter. **Students will need to wear masks where physical distancing is not possible and/or when they are not in class with their cohort.** Many or most will choose to always wear a mask.

We are very excited to welcome everyone back to school, but the school experience will be different. Health and safety protocols guide how we open and run the school. We have to keep an emphasis on social distancing, so **lockers will not be issued and students will be expected to leave the property, if they are not under direct instruction. Masks must be outside the classroom.** We expect that we will provide each student two washable masks. Many or most students have access to their own masks. We will continue to communicate with our parents through our Website: www.surreyschools.ca/fraserheights our Firehawk Appazur App (available to download for free on the IOS App store and the Google Play site, search for Firehawk). We may do weekly or bi-monthly principal updates. We will also push emails to families.

I know that coming to school, interacting with friends and peers, and learning directly from a teacher is incredibly important. I also know that re-timetabling students in August is challenging and forces us to make some hard choices. For example, **we had to assign electives to Grade 8 and 9 student learning groups and these may not be what your son/daughter originally hoped for.** Please support us in recognizing there is intrinsic value in learning, regardless of subject. Once we form cohorts in the first quarter, we cannot be shifting students around. Therefore, there will be very little opportunity for students to

change courses in quarter one. These realities underlie our present situation. We rebuilt our timetable under really tight time constraints and hard decisions had to be made. We tried to maintain senior electives as much as we could. This is because in the senior grades, those choices really expand and they are, in many cases, much more intentionally linked to the student's post-secondary plans.

Our hope is that next year, if we do not yet have an effective vaccine and/or treatment for COVID19, that we will be able to timetable and plan for more students getting the elective or elective choice or rotation they want.

Last May and June, we asked our teachers to think deeply about what the critical elements are for each course they teach. These will be their prime instructional focus. We will move fairly quickly. Teachers will focus on the essential questions, the skills associated with answering such questions and the content that must be assimilated. Fraser Height's students are generally focused on learning and growing as learners and leaders. **When learning begins, we ask our students to continue to do what you always do, which is doing your absolute best in everything required and taking great pride in all you do.**

We expect to open this year at about 1400 students. This summer, we received one additional portable. We are still hiring teachers. Through the summer, we had a number of staffing placements. We welcome or welcome back:

Grades 10-12, 325 minutes

- Students report to school 10 minutes prior to class start time.
- We expect a stretch break from about 10:20-10:30 AM and 1:40 -1:50 PM on Tue, Wed and Thu only.
- Four days a week senior students must leave the school once their morning class ends (they cannot stay here at lunch).
- Students in Block C are online through TEAMS 4 days per week. One third of grade 10-12 students remain for face to face Block C on either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. Their Block C teacher will tell them their day.
- Masks must be worn when in common areas or outside the class. In-class is optional as students are in their cohort group. We support students wearing masks all the time.

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is a major factor contributing to student success in school. We expect that students enrolled at Fraser Heights Secondary will attend school regularly and arrive to class on time. If a student is absent, parents are requested to phone or email the school on the morning of the absence. If this is not possible, please send a note with your child to turn into the office on the day they return to school.

NO HAT POLICY

This is a reminder that Fraser Heights has a no hat policy. This includes baseball caps, toques, bandanas, and headbands. This is primarily for safety reasons as it allows our school staff to identify people who shouldn't be in our building much more effectively. **However, masks are required on the bus and in hallways, common areas and many students will wear masks all their time at school.**

LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

In some cases, it may be necessary for students to leave school before the end of the school day. Students wishing to leave the school early must come to the office and sign out. In order to sign out, students must have written permission from their parent/guardian. In cases where written permission is not provided, the office staff will contact parents or guardians for verification.

PARKING

There are a very limited number of parking spaces for students on school property. Students wishing to have the privilege of parking their car on school property must register their vehicle at the office. There is no charge for student parking, however, parking spots are available each morning on a first come, first served basis. Please Note: Students must park in marked parking stalls. If our parking lot is full, we are allowed to park in the Surrey Parks & Recreation parking lot along 160th Street.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

We recommend that students purchase school supplies after they have met with their subject teachers during the first week of school.

SNOW DAYS

Dr. Jordan Tinney, Surrey School District's Superintendent, makes the final call on snow closure days. On heavy snow days, when snowfall may cause problems with transportation and roads, Fraser Heights Administration may shorten lunch by up to 30 minutes and dismiss students early.
