Students will need to earn a minimum of 80 credits to graduate. These 80 credits must consist of specific required courses as well as elective courses. It is important to review and choose your courses wisely. You need to ensure you have enough credits to meet graduation requirements. When you choose your electives, keep in mind your goals or plans for after high school graduation. Courses with insufficient enrollment will not be offered; therefore, it is important that students choose alternate electives with care.
