Dear Parent/Guardian & Student,

I am happy to share with you that our Grade 11 students and our school are to be profiled in a radio documentary.

After a proposal was reviewed at the district level and with our staff, our administrators met with the CBC Early Edition radio show host Stephen Quinn, his producer and reporter at our school to discuss the idea of having a reporter at our school for four weeks to learn about school life for our Grade 11 students.

Beginning February 19, the reporter will visit classrooms and talk with some students and staff before assembling his report for broadcast over a number of days on CBC Radio's Early Edition starting in April. Stories will also appear on the CBC website and possibly in a podcast.

CBC's intent is to explore the goals, challenges and day-to-day activities of a Grade 11 L.A. Matheson Secondary student. CBC will also ask what are important issues for our students and how they view the issues in their community.

Of course, no student will be publicly identified in the documentary unless the student and parent/guardian approve, so we will be distributing the district media consent form for Grade 11 students and parent signatures.

We are satisfied the CBC is approaching this project in a professional and sensitive manner and we are very excited for this opportunity.
