To the Parents/Guardians of Martha Currie Students,

As we mentioned in the previous Parent Update, you will be getting information this week about how you will receive your child's final Summative Report Card. Your classroom teacher will be sending you specific information by tomorrow, but we wanted to give you an overview, as different classes are doing different setups. Please note that it is an unusual year in that we had to set up different reporting timelines for our staff, so reports may be handed out on a flexible schedule.

My child is currently attending in-school learning:

-Your child will be given the report on one of the days that he/she is in school. This can be as early as Thursday, June 18th.

My child is in Grade 7:

-Reports will be handed out at the Grade 7 Celebration on June 24th.

My child is in Kindergarten:

-Your child is welcome to come say good-bye to the teacher on June 17th. This will be located outdoors. Your teacher will send you the information.

My child is a between Grades 1 to 6 and not attending school:

-Some of our teachers will be sending you a time/date that students are welcome to come say bye to the teacher and do the pickup. This will all be outdoors.

-Some of our teachers are unable to offer this for health-concern reasons, so they will let you know what the plan is for pickup.

What if I am unable to attend my scheduled date for pickup?

-In this case, your teacher will arrange with you another opportunity for pickup. These other opportunities will often be at either 8:30am or 2:30pm on specific days. By pre-arranging, the teacher will be sure to have the report ready to give to you when you arrive. The location is where teachers currently drop off and pick up their in-school classes every day (back of the school or gravel field). Your teacher will let you know the details.

-We recognize this multiple-dates schedule can be a particular challenge for parents with multiple kids. Our teachers will do their best to try to accommodate you. Please contact them.

-Your child is welcome to do the pickup on their own.

What if I forget and don't pick up the report?

-We will hold the reports until September and send them home with your child at that time.
