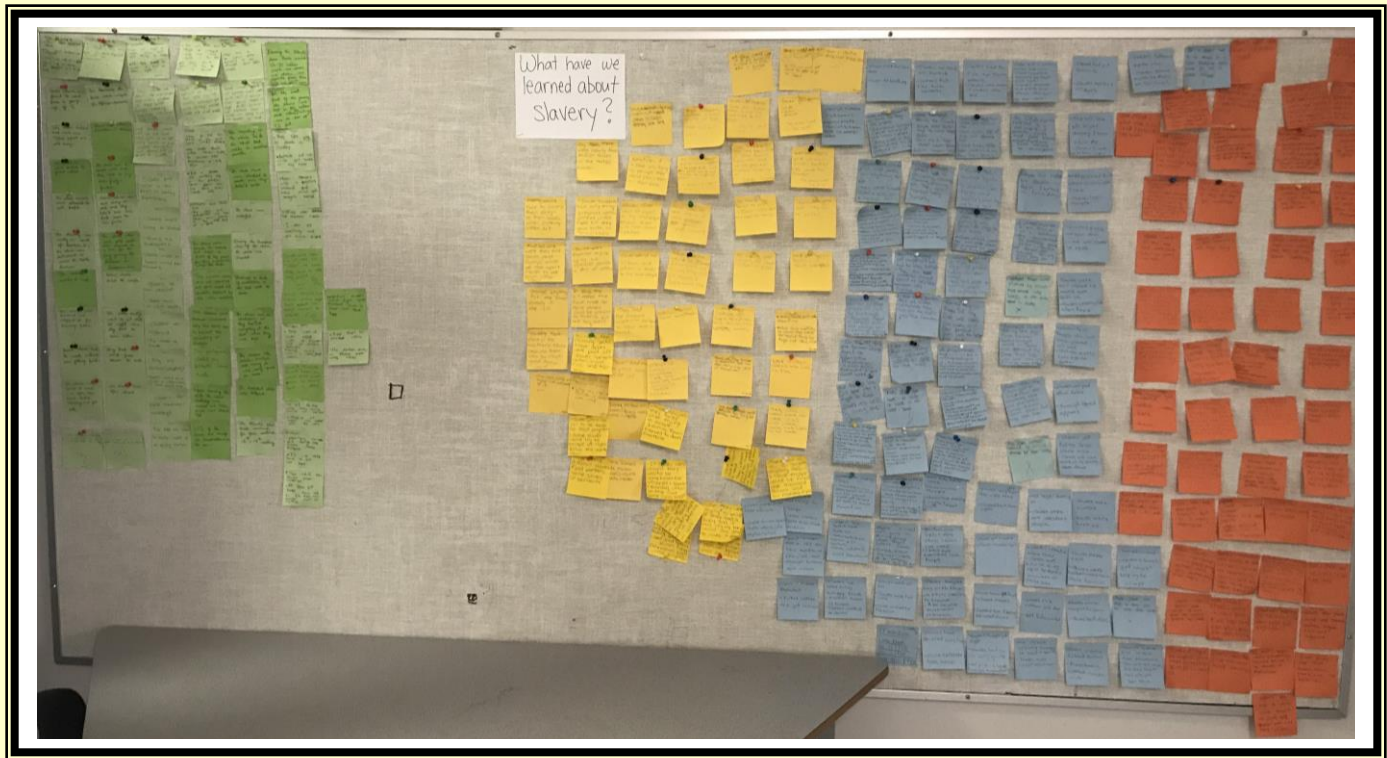
We would like to give an early reminder of the PAC Meeting coming up on Feb. 4th. All Martha Currie parents are welcome to attend!
