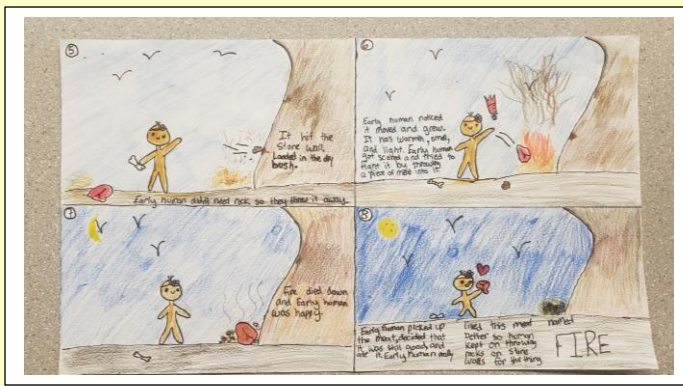
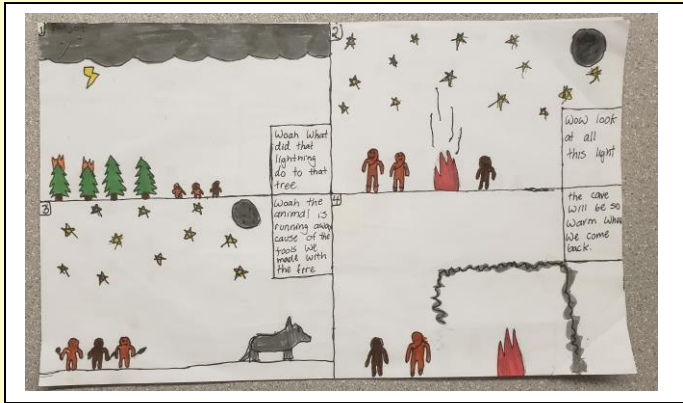
He squeaked "Hey, that's mine, I found it first". Then he realised it was Bob. Bob took the jewels and flew away.

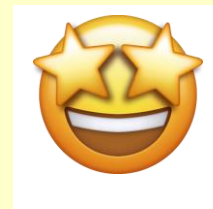
