Message from the Admin

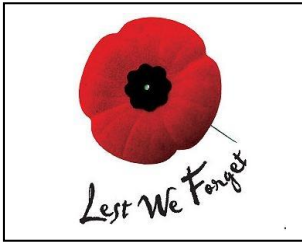
