Tuesday - Canned fruit & vegetables: peaches, fruit mix, green beans, corn, peas, etc.

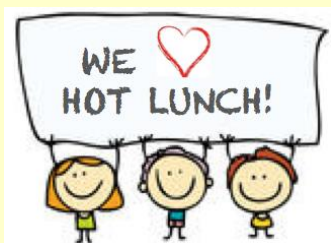
Wednesday - Pasta, mac & cheese, cereal, rice, dry soup, pasta sauces, etc.
