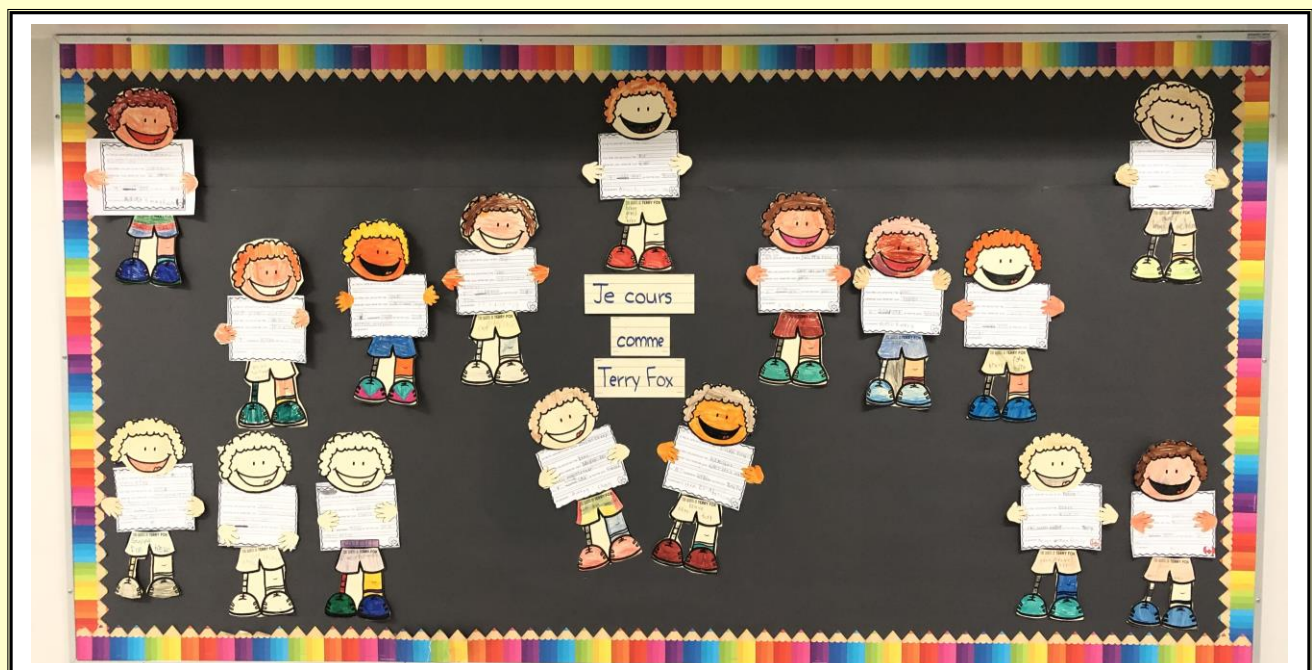


**Terry Fox Run
