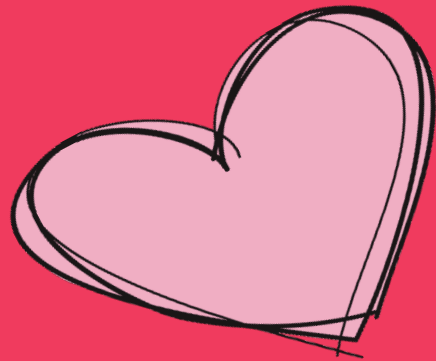

District/Authority Scholarships

\$1,250

District/Authority Scholarships - \$1,250

The Ministry of Education designs these awards to acknowledge excellence in fields other than academics. Awards are given to students who have excelled in the following areas:

- Indigenous Languages and Culture
- Fine Arts (Visual Art, Dance, Drama, Music)
- Applied Skills (Business Education, Tech Education, Home Economics)
- Physical Activity (Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics)
- Second Languages (French and Spanish)
- Community Service (volunteering – in school and in the community)
- Technical & Trades Training (Carpentry, Automotive, Cafeteria etc.)

You must be nominated by a teacher in order to apply!

Applications are due in the Career Centre by April 15, 2020 before 4:00 pm

District/Authority Scholarships

How to get nominated for a District/Authority Scholarship:

1. Pick up an application from the Career Centre.
2. Ask your teacher to nominate you. The nominating teacher must sign the District/Authority Scholarship application form.
3. A transcript is **NOT** needed for the application.
4. A Reference Letter is only needed for **Community Service** or **Indigenous Languages and Culture** performed outside of school.
5. Submit your signed & completed application to the Career Centre.

Applications are due in the Career Centre by April 15, 2020 before 4:00 pm

District/Authority Scholarships

- Students can be nominated by more than one department, however only ONE District/Authority Scholarship will be awarded per student.
- Priority will be given to students who also apply for a NSSS In-School Scholarship.

Complete application on a PC computer. Do not use a MAC!

REMEMBER TO DOWNLOAD AND SAVE THE IN-SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PDF FILE BEFORE YOU START FILLING IN YOUR RESPONSES....THEN, ONCE IT IS SAVED ON YOUR COMPUTER/DRIVE, YOU CAN FILL OUT THE ASSIGNMENT AND "SAVE AS" (be sure to rename the file when you save it to include your name eg. "John Smith In-School Scholarship Application") if you do not re-name the file, your responses will not be saved and you will be emailing a blank form!

NSSS In-School Scholarships

- Applications for in-school scholarships are due electronically. Please email your completed application to **NSSSCareers@gmail.com**
- Your application **has not** been received until you receive a **confirmation email** (*it will take a few minutes to get your confirmation email*).
- If you did not receive a confirmation email, please come to the Career Centre (before April 15!!) and ask Ms. Baig to check if she's received your application. Apply early!!

Applications are due by April 15, 2020 **BEFORE 4:00 pm**
Late applications will not be accepted!!

NSSS In-School Scholarships

- Important!!! All electronic applications must be completed on a PC, not a Mac computer!
- Remember to **download and save** the NSSS In-School Scholarship application **BEFORE** you start filling in your responses!
- Be sure to rename the file when you save it with your **first and last name**, for example:

“Beyonce Knowles-Carter In-School Scholarship Application”



NSSS In-School Scholarships

- You **MUST** have a Social Insurance Number in order to receive an award
- International students are not eligible to apply
- **Do not** ask teachers for reference letters
- Transcript is **not** required
- Do the Math and add up all of your Community & Volunteer hours on the application
- If claiming Financial Need, you must attach proof of **family income**

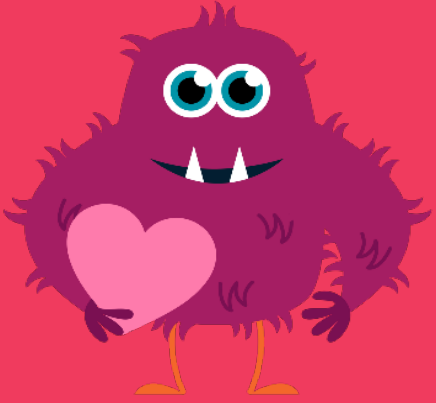
