To help schools and families prepare for the delivery of at-home learning, teachers will begin connecting with families by phone and/or email **this week**. The purpose will be to gather information needed for teachers to continue planning for delivery of learning in this new format. Please be ready to answer basic questions around needs and supports for your child and family.

If students have not received any communication from their teachers by the end of the day Thursday April 2, please contact the school email account at northsurrey@surreyschools.ca and give us the following critical information:

1. Student's first and last name **and** student number
2. Student's contact email address and phone number
3. Parent's preferred email address and phone number

For students wanting to visit the school to retrieve essential belongings, resources, and supplies, this will be organized at some point later with a plan to ensure the safety of staff, students and families. We will be communicating this information once our plans and schedules are finalized. **At this time students and parents are not expected to be coming to school for any reason.**

For the week of **April 6**, you can expect calls and/or emails from your student's teachers with some sharing of online educational resources and information around the continuation of learning. By the week of **April 14**, we are planning to provide consistent learning opportunities for our students based on the information we have collected during the previous two weeks.

As we all know, this is an unprecedented time, and we will strive to do our best to support our students and families. Also, please keep in mind circumstances and expectations may change as we go along this unique journey.
