Skills Exploration 10 will give students entering grade 10 the opportunity to experience a hands-on introduction to the construction trades of carpentry, electrical, plumbing and welding. Students will learn essential skills such as how to measure, cut, wire, build and weld; skills and attitudes needed for success in school and the workplace; benefits of Apprenticeship and Surrey District Partnership Programs, and career-related opportunities.

This is a very labour intensive program. Students must be able to work independently on a job-site environment with minimum one-on-one instruction.
