## OCTOBER

**The Loran Award** (formerly the Canadian Merit Scholarship) Foundation. Up to 34 awards valued up to \$100,000 over 4 years. There are also many Loran Finalist Awards of \$5000 offered to national finalists, plus Loran Provincial Awards valued at \$2000. Three applicants from the school may be selected for sponsored status, but students may also apply for direct entry.

Criteria: 85% min. academic average, strong moral character, service, commitment to larger community and leadership; curious about nature, willing to take meaningful risks and interested in a wide range of subjects.
