

Admission Procedures Checklist

- Surrey Community College application form and \$80 non-refundable registration fee. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency: Canadian Birth Certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian Citizenship Card or Permanent Residence Card.
- Proof of secondary school completion
- English 12 with a minimum grade of C+ (67%) or Communications 12 with a minimum grade of A (86%) or a post-secondary English course with a minimum grade of C- (50%) from a recognized post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction in the past 5 years. An English assessment may be required.
